
Task 1. Workshop 2024



CHALLENGES

- Low participation from the south-west region
- Lack of enough funding to compensate volunteers/staff to organize more networking and workshop sessions
- Difficulty in mobilization of goods/resources to conduct lessons
- Lack of enough preparation time prior to event dates.
- Difficulty of movement around the regions due to safety concerns and lack of private vehicle.
- Lack of opportunities to apply for national and international funding.
- Lack of a centralized office to properly manage activities.
- Lack of enough resources, including laptops, office stationeries to work towards engaging kids in schools.

FUTURE PESPECTIVES

As we step into 2025, our focus remains on expanding our reach, forming stronger partnerships, and amplifying the impact of our initiatives. We will continue to invest in programs that empower children, students, and communities, ensuring they are well-equipped to seize future opportunities.

Establishment of Vocational Centers

We propose to open three vocational centers in Buea, Bamenda, and Mamfe, with the primary goal of empowering individuals through skill development. These centers will focus on providing training in tailoring, carpentry, and sustainable agriculture. By equipping individuals with practical skills, we aim to create opportunities for self-reliance and economic growth within these communities.

Design and Multimedia Center

A dedicated design and multimedia center will be established, alongside our vocational centers. These will be equipped with laptops and advanced software for design and simulation. This center will focus on training participants to use scientific approach to solving community problems. Participants will be supporting projects related to product development, building design, waste disposal, water projects, drought evaluation, fostering innovation and creativity among local talents.

Promotion of Sustainable Agriculture

To enhance agricultural productivity and food security, we plan to partner with qualified professionals to conduct workshops and hands-on fieldwork. These initiatives will focus on teaching sustainable farming techniques and promoting best practices that can increase yields while preserving the environment.

Clean Water Access Project

Recognizing the importance of clean water for health and well-being, this project will involve working with local communities and partners to build water catchments and purification points.

These efforts will ensure access to safe and clean drinking water, significantly improving the quality of life in targeted areas.

Solar Energy Solutions

In regions disconnected from the main power grid, we aim to implement solar lighting projects. By providing sustainable and reliable energy solutions, this initiative will enhance living conditions and support local development activities.

Mobile Healthcare Clinics

To address healthcare challenges in remote areas, we plan to organize mobile clinics staffed by trained nurses and healthcare professionals. These mobile units will deliver essential medical services, including preventive care, diagnosis, and treatment, to communities with limited access to healthcare facilities.
